


The National Survey of Independent Chinese Secondary Schools 2016-2017

Introduction

The National Survey of Independent Chinese Secondary Schools 2016-2017 consists of 5 different areas: School (facilities and structure), School Leadership, Teacher, Student and Parent/Guardian, in order to collect comprehensive responses and to understand the current situation of Independent Chinese Secondary School.

This particular questionnaire: Parent/Guardian questionnaire will be distributed to all Independent Chinese Secondary Schools' Junior Middle 1 and Senior Middle 3 student's parent respectively. The included topics are as follow:
